At the Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Bath County, Virginia, Lynn Ellen Black, Chairperson; Roy W. Burns, Vice-Chairman; H. Lee Fry, John A. Lockridge, and Ronald R. Shifflett, Supervisors; Julian Harf, County Attorney; and Michael J. Bender, Jr., County Administrator.

Chairperson Black called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

County Administrator Bender called the roll.

Present: Chairperson Black, Supervisor Burns, Supervisor Fry, Supervisor Lockridge, and Supervisor Shifflett.

Chairperson Black led the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed.

Chairperson Black asked the Board if they wished to approve or amend the agenda.

Supervisor Burns made the motion to approve the agenda with one addition: under item 9 schedule a Board of Supervisors work session. Supervisor Lockridge seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Chairperson Black asked the Board if they wished to approve or amend the minutes from the August 13, 2024, Board of Supervisors monthly meeting.

Supervisor Lockridge made the motion to approve the minutes of the August 13, 2024, Board of Supervisors monthly meeting as presented. Supervisor Shifflett seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Public Comment

Linda Puhle, Millboro District addressed the Board of Supervisors regarding comments from the August 13, 2024, Board of Supervisors meeting. Ms. Puhle thanked the Board of Supervisors for approving the additional appropriation to fund athletics through the end of the 2025 school year. Ms. Puhle expressed concerns that members of the community and the Board of Supervisors value athletics more than education. Ms. Puhle stated that athletics is now fully funded but what about educational materials and school nurses.

Stephen Hiner, Warm Springs District encouraged the Board of Supervisors to find out what's going on with the Jackson River Trail portion in Cedar Creek. A recent article in the Recorder reported concerns brought forth by the Jackson River Preservation Association

concerning discharge into Cedar Creek and Jackson River from construction along the Jackson River Scenic Trail.

Jeff Grimm, Millboro District urged the Board of Supervisors to consider hiring a grant writer.

Lisa Hamilton, Warm Springs District asked the Board of Supervisors about their plans for the future of Bath County. Ms. Hamilton encouraged the Board to be proactive and find out what other small localities are doing to increase revenue.

Board Chair Report

Chairperson Black read updates provided by Kevin Kyle, USFS District Ranger regarding Lake Moomaw. Chairperson Black commended Millboro Area Rescue Squad for being named Outstanding EMS agency by Central Shenandoah EMS Council. Millboro Area Rescue Squad is eligible for the 2024 Governor's Award later this year.

Comprehensive Plan for 2024-2029

Supervisor Burns made the motion to adopt the Bath County Comprehensive Plan for 2024-2029. Supervisor Fry seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting ave.

Proclamation honoring the 100th anniversary of the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club

Chairperson Black read the following proclamation honoring the 100th anniversary of the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club.

WHEREAS the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club was established in 1924 to promote the interest in growth and cultivation of flowers and vegetables, and in beautifying the home grounds throughout the Valley; and

WHEREAS, the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club was responsible for the 40-year restoration project of the Warm Springs Valley Cemetery, circa 1800; and

WHEREAS, the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club has a rich history of supporting community projects.; and

WHEREAS, the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club has provided financial and in-kind support to the Bath County Public Library, Warm Springs Welcome Center, Bath County Historical Society, Bath County Public Schools, Bath County Airport Authority, Garth Newel Music Center, and many other organizations throughout Bath County; and

WHEREAS, the Warm Springs Valley Garden club has undertaken many beautification projects over the years including holiday decorations at Bath Community Hospital, The Springs Nursing Home, and other public buildings; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, We, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Bath, Commonwealth of Virginia, on behalf of the County and its citizens, do hereby recognize the service that the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club has provided the community and hereby proclaim this 10th Day of September 2024, as Garden Club Appreciation Day in honor of the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club.

Highland Children's House Presentation

Callie Smith, Highland Children's House Executive Director provided an overview including per day rates, enrollment, staffing, and grant funding for the Hot Springs location. Ms. Smith announced that Highland Children's House is working with Bath County Schools to open a before and after school program for elementary school aged children. Ms. Smith answered questions from the Board of Supervisors.

Bath County Airport Authority Presentation

Jeff Ford, Bath County Airport Authority Chairman gave a brief presentation of terminal replacement and other improvements at Ingalls Field. Mr. Ford explained the terminal project and improvements are being funded primarily by grants with a local match funded by Visit Bath County.

Municipal Solid Waste Update

County Administrator Bender explained the revised Solid Waste Ordinance was enacted by the Board of Supervisors on May 14, 2024, the scales are operational, and staff has started billing according to the new guidelines. County Administrator Bender reported that since the new guidelines have been in effect, the amount of brush and tires being hauled to the transfer station have declined significantly. County Administrator Bender gave an update on replacing compactors and site work required before installing the new compactors.

Schedule Board of Supervisors Work Session

After discussion the Board of Supervisors set a work session for Wednesday, October 25, 2024, at 6 p.m. at Millboro Elementary School.

Appointments to Boards and Commissions

Supervisor Shifflett made the motion to appoint County Administrator Bender to the Shenandoah Valley Workforce Development Board Elected Officials Consortium. Supervisor Burns seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

The Board of Supervisors will consider a private sector representative for the Shenandoah Valley Workforce Development Board and a Board of Supervisors Member for the Shenandoah Valley Workforce Development Board Elected Officials Consortium at their meeting in October.

Building Permit Refund Request

Cynthia Crowder, Valley Springs District applied for building permit number 018-2024 in March 2024. Ms. Crowder has not started the project, and unforeseen circumstances will not allow her to move forward with the project. Ms. Crowder is requesting a refund of \$753.20 the cost of the building permit less a \$10 handling fee.

Supervisor Burns made the motion to approve the request for a refund of building permit number 018-2024 in the amount of \$753.20. Supervisor Lockridge seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Consent Agenda

Supervisor Burns made the motion to approve payment of invoices, requests for transfers and appropriations, correspondence, and monthly reports as presented. Supervisor Lockridge seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Public Comment

Amy Porterfield, Rockridge Regional Library, Bath Branch Manager announced that the library is now open on Fridays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Linda Puhle, Millboro District asked the Board to have people making public comments clearly identify themselves for the record. Ms. Puhle spoke concerning the importance of the LCI and school funding.

Supervisor Burns read comments submitted by Lyle Kampf, Warm Springs District regarding road conditions and motorcycle safety. Mr. Kampf also commented on student academic achievements at Bath County schools. Mr. Kampf wondered why the Board of Supervisors drastically cut the schools budget when they should have been praising and rewarding their efforts.

Jeff Cleek, Warm Springs District agreed with earlier comments about hiring a grant writer.

Board Member Comment

Supervisor Fry thanked the Airport Authority and Warm Springs Valley Garden Club for their presentations.

Supervisor Burns expressed condolences to Amy Porterfield's family for the recent loss of her mother and thanked the Warm Springs Valley Garden Club for their service to the community.

Supervisor Lockridge thanked the public in attendance. Supervisor Lockridge asked everyone to keep Jimbo Tennant, who was injured in an accident and the Family of Butch Hall who passed away recently in their thoughts and prayers. Supervisor Lockridge thanked the County Administrator and Jeff Grimm for their work in obtaining grants for the radio project.

Supervisor Shifflett spoke in support of a grant writer but felt some of the work could be accomplished using students and volunteers.

Chairperson Black also agreed the County would benefit from a grant writer. Chairperson Black provided expenditures associated with developing the property and adding improvements for the childcare facility.

Closed Session

Supervisor Burns made the motion to convene the Board of Supervisors in closed meeting pursuant to Virginia Code §2.2-3711(A)(8) to obtain legal advice concerning prayer in public meetings. Supervisor Fry seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Supervisor Lockridge made the motion to end the closed session of the Board of Supervisors and reconvene the regular meeting. Supervisor Burns seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

Supervisors Lockridge moved pursuant to Virginia Code §2.2-3712(D) that the Board of Supervisors certify that, to the best of each member's knowledge, only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters were identified in the motion convening the closed meeting were heard, discussed, or considered during the closed meeting. Supervisor Burns seconded the motion, which was adopted 5 in favor, 0 against, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Fry, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye.

There were no actions as a result of closed session.

County of Bath, Virginia Board of Supervisors Meeting Millboro Elementary School Wednesday, September 25, 2024, 6:00 P.M. Work Session

At the work session of the Board of Supervisors of Bath County, Virginia, Lynn Ellen Black, Chairperson; Roy W. Burns, Vice-Chairman; John A. Lockridge, and Ronald R. Shifflett, Supervisors; and Michael J. Bender, Jr., County Administrator. Supervisor H. Lee Fry was absent from the meeting.

Chairperson Black called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

County Administrator Bender distributed cost and pick up information for the twelve (12) greenbox sites and a summary of estimates for purchase and installation of compactors at Ashwood and Millboro Springs.

The Board of Supervisors discussed quotes provided by vendors S.L. Container Co., Mid-Atlantic Waste, and SP Industries. Factors for the final decision will include upfront costs, motor power, expected life span, maintenance costs, operational efficiency, and total cost of ownership.

Supervisor Burns asked County Administrator Bender to provide an overview of site work needed at each location. Board members felt it would be beneficial if the County owned the property before going to the expense of installing compactors. The Board of Supervisors discussed manned compactor sites.

Supervisor Lockridge provided projected cost savings based on greenbox sites being closed with solid waste being routed to centralized compactor sites.

Board members discussed how closing greenbox sites would impact the general public and if compactor sites would be able to handle the increase in waste.

County Administrator Bender suggested closing one site at a time and taking time to evaluate the impacts and educate the public before moving forward.

Members of the public shared their thoughts on recycling, greenbox sites, and how to prevent out of county trash.

Supervisor Shifflett stated that he thought the County would see a considerable cost savings in the long term. Supervisor Shifflett explained there are several greenbox sites within a few miles of each other.

Supervisor Lockridge stated he did not realize the cost to dispose of solid waste until the Board began discussions to revise the municipal solid waste ordinance.

County Administrator Bender explained that taxpayers have subsidized trash removal for years. A draft of revisions from the County Attorney will be ready for the Board f Supervisors review in October.

Supervisor Lockridge made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Burns seconded the motion, which was adopted 4 in favor, and 0 against, 1 absent, with Supervisors Black, Burns, Lockridge, and Shifflett voting aye. Supervisor Fry was absent.

Chairperson Black adjourned the work session.

Ordered that this Board is now adjourned.

Proclamation Declaring Bath County a Stroke Smart County

WHEREAS, 1 in 6 people will have a stroke in their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, stroke is the leading cause of long-term disability; and

WHEREAS, there are lifesaving treatments that must be administered in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the majority of people do not recognize stroke symptoms or understand the need to call 911 immediately; and

WHEREAS, access to the most advanced care for certain types of strokes may not be available at all healthcare facilities; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services providers are trained to identify stroke symptoms and choose the appropriate facility based on specific symptoms; and

WHEREAS, early identification of stroke symptoms and prompt activation of emergency services can save lives and reduce long-term disability; and

WHEREAS, Bath County seeks to be an example to other communities in Virginia through educating the public about stroke recognition and emergency care; and

WHEREAS, the Bath County Board of Supervisors commits to partner with the Central Shenandoah EMS Council, Central Shenandoah Health District, Bath Community Hospital, and Augusta Health, to increase stroke awareness in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Bath County Board of Supervisors, do hereby proclaim Bath County a Stroke Smart County, and call this observance to the attention of all citizens of Bath County.

The Board of Supervisors directed County Administrator Bender to work with the County Attorney to research and develop an ordinance establishing reasonable fees for the use of emergency medical services vehicles.

RECOMMENDATION:

Set public hearing to solicit public input at the November 12, 2024, Board of Supervisors Meeting at 6 p.m. or soon thereafter. A draft ordinance is attached for the Board's consideration.

AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT ARTICLE XIV OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE BATH COUNTY CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING REASONABLE FEES FOR THE USE OF BATH COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Virginia Code § 32.1-111.14(B) authorizes counties to make reasonable charges for the use of emergency services vehicles, including charging insurers pursuant to Virginia Code § 38.2-3407.9; and

WHEREAS, establishing reasonable charges for the use of Bath County emergency medical services vehicles will assist in ensuring the provision of adequate and continuing emergency medical services in Bath County, and in preserving, protecting, and promoting the public health, safety and general welfare of Bath County citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Bath County, Virginia, that Article XIV, Chapter 15 of the Bath County Code is hereby enacted, to include the following sections:

ARTICLE XIV – FEES FOR THE USE OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES VEHICLES

Sec. 15-85. Definitions.

County means Bath County, Virginia.

Emergency medical services or EMS means health care, public health, and public safety services used in the medical response to the real or perceived need for immediate medical assessment, care, or transportation and preventive care or transportation in order to prevent loss of life or aggravation of physiological or psychological illness or injury.

Emergency medical services vehicle or EMS vehicle means any vehicle, vessel, or aircraft that holds a valid emergency medical services vehicle permit issued by the Virginia Office of Emergency Medical Services that is equipped, maintained, or operated to provide emergency medical care or transportation of patients who are sick, injured, wounded, or otherwise incapacitated or helpless.

EMS Personnel means individuals responsible for the direct provision of emergency medical services in a given medical emergency.

Patient means any individual requiring transportation by County EMS vehicles.

Sec. 15-86. Service Fees for Emergency Medical Services Transport.

The County shall charge reasonable fees whenever County EMS personnel (employees or volunteers) provide EMS vehicle transportation to a patient, and shall have the right to charge such fees to insurers. The schedule of fees shall be established by resolution of the Bath County Board of Supervisors. All funds received from payment of these fees shall be paid into the County's general fund.

Sec. 15-87. Patient Categories for Billing.

- (a) A bill will be generated for all EMS vehicle transports by County EMS personnel regardless of whether the personnel are volunteers or County employees.
- (b) For billing purposes, patients will fall into one of the following categories:
 - i. *Insured residents*. For insured residents, the patient's insurance carrier will be billed. The resident patient will not be charged an out-of-pocket expense, pursuant to Section 15-88(a).
 - ii. *Insured non-residents*. For insured non-residents, the patient's insurance carrier will be billed and the non-resident will receive a bill for any applicable co-pays and/or deductibles.
 - iii. Uninsured residents. The patient will receive a bill for the full amount minus the average co-pay amount for the service. However, the patient may be eligible for a waiver of fees if he or she can demonstrate financial hardship in accordance with the compassionate billing policy (Sec. 15-88).
 - iv. Uninsured non-residents. The County will bill to the patient for the full amount. The patient must pay the bill in full unless he or she can demonstrate financial hardship in accordance with the compassionate billing policy (Sec. 15-88).
 - v. County responsibility. For all bills generated that the County Administrator or his designee determines the County is responsible to pay, the County will reflect its responsibility in its internal accounting records and show a zero balance on the bill. The County will not turn these bills over to the billing contractor for billing or collection.
 - vi. *Inmates*. When an inmate of a local, state, or federal correctional facility is transported, the appropriate agency in charge of the facility will be billed.

Sec. 15-88. Compassionate Billing Policy.

- (a) Compassionate billing is intended to eliminate out-of-pocket expenses for residents who receive EMS transport services, and for non-residents who meet the criteria described in subsection e. The County regards taxes paid by its residents as co-pays and/or deductibles for EMS transport services. Non-County residents will be assessed standard deductibles and co-pays in addition to the amount(s) approved by the insurance provider(s).
- (b) No patient shall be denied necessary medical transport services due to his or her inability to pay or lack of insurance.
- (c) All patients will be asked to provide their insurance information in writing.
- (d) All patients will receive notification of the value of services rendered and notice of billing forwarded to their insurer(s), if applicable.
- (e) Any patient lacking health insurance may submit a declaration of financial hardship and request for waiver. The declaration must establish either (a) that the patient resides in a household with a household income that is less than the most recent annual median household income for Bath County, Virginia, as determined by the U.S. Census Bureau; or (b) that the fees will endanger the financial health of the individual.

- (f) All requests for waiver will be reviewed by the County Administrator or his designee, who will provide a written response to the requesting patient as to whether the patient's request for waiver is granted and the reason(s) for the decision.
- (g) If any insured patient requires EMS transport within a given calendar year that exceeds his or her insurance coverage limits and no additional insurance coverage is available, the fees for service beyond coverage limits will be waived by the County.

Sec. 15-89. Billing and Collections Procedure.

(a) The County will use a third-party contractor for billing and collections services. The company will not pursue payment recovery through a debt collection agency without express authorization from the County Administrator or his designee.

BACKGROUND:

To form a Local VA250 Committee and join in the planning for this large-scale commemoration, the local governing body must designate a liaison to work with the Commission, who will serve as the local contact with the state commission, participate in planning events, and communicate regularly on events occurring within the locality. While the Commission is planning statewide programs and events, including traveling exhibitions, strong involvement at the local level is crucial. The Commission is working with hundreds of partners across the state to encourage and support local participation. Local history, after all, is the foundation on which all else is built.

- 2. Economic development
- 3. Education primary through college level where possible
- 4. Tribal representatives
- 5. Museums and historic sites
- 6. Local historical and cultural groups
- 7. Local governing body
